

## Curriculum Development Workshop for Nursing Programme



**A national Workshop for "Development of Curriculum for Certificate Nursing Course at Karnali Academy of Health Sciences, Jumla" was held between 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2013, in Kathmandu.**
